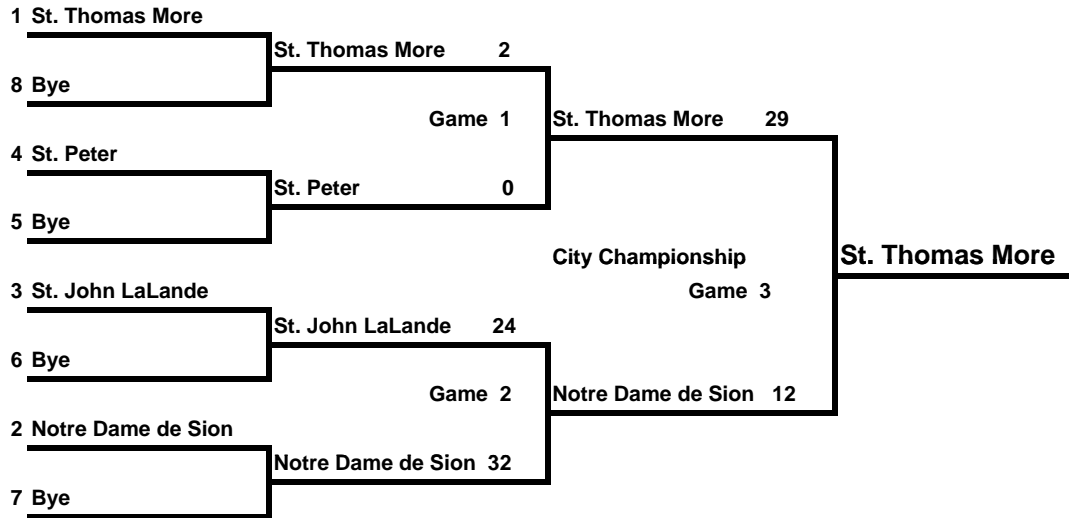

The City Tournament will be played in accordance with all PLKC rules & regulations.

During all semi-final and final games, a League Representative will be present to monitor playing time. Each player must play one uninterrupted quarter during each game. If health, injury, or disciplinary action prevents a team player from participating, then the coach must state to the official scorekeeper before the game. If a player gets sick or injured during the game that player can and should be removed. At the semi-final and final game the League Representative present will inform each team the status of each players playing time at half-time and the end of the third quarter. If a player has four fouls at the start of the fourth quarter and has not played an uninterrupted quarter during the game, then that player must start and play the entire fourth quarter or until he/she fouls out of the game. At that time the player may be replaced, if any substitutes remain. Failure to follow the uninterrupted quarter rule will result in an immediate forfeit by the team in violation. The decision will rest solely with the League Representative. NO APPEALS WILL BE ALLOWED. PLAY LIKE A CHAMPION TODAY.
